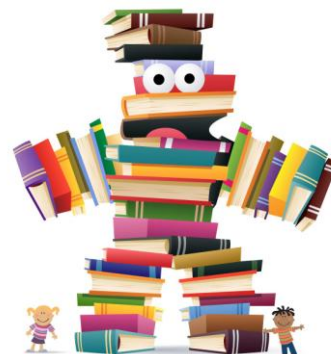
Cumann na mBunscol - Mini 7s
