These trips are being generously subsidised by our Parents' Association and we ask the pupils to contribute **five euro** each to help cover the costs of the bus.

Pupils **must wear their school uniforms; bring a packed lunch** (1 treat allowed) and **a coat**. Weather dependant, pupils should also bring a change of clothes as we will be walking around Dublin and may get wet. The bus will leave from the school at **8.30 am** and return at approximately 8.30 pm.

We will stop at Applegreen on the way home where pupils will have the opportunity to buy dinner if they wish. (Max spending money €5) Pupils should not bring any other money as there will be no opportunity to spend it. Thank you for your co-operation.
